SPLASH SWIM SCHOOL!

We are delighted to announce the opening of the Splash Swim School!

Open year round and located at 1110 W. Prospect Rd. in Ft. Collins (northwest corner of Shields and Prospect).

We will offer a variety of small group and private lessons for all ages along with pool party rentals, dive in movies, stroke clinics, and other fun activities. This is a **WARM** water pool designed with the comfort of your family at heart!

POOL PARTY INFORMATION

Please schedule all parties and/or group gatherings (daytime or private) through the pool manager **At LEAST ONE WEEK IN ADVANCE**. Your group may be turned away if you don't have prior approval through management.

Daytime Gatherings

Gatherings with over 10 people held during general swim hours must be prearranged. Hosts will be asked to pay for a lifeguard hired specifically for their group at the rate of \$20/hour in addition to the facility fee and deposit. The maximum number of guests allowed during general swim hours is 25.

Private Parties

Gatherings of more than 25 guests are permitted between 8pm-10pm.

The following fees apply to pool gatherings:

Deposit—Payable to Westfield Pool

\$75 daytime

\$150 after hours

Facility Fee—Payable to Westfield Pool

\$20/hr. clubhouse only

\$30 pool without clubhouse or

\$50 pool and clubhouse

Lifeguards—Payable to Splash

\$20/hour/guard

(3 guard minimum after hours)

Ask the pool manager how you can pay online!

Lifetime members receive one free facility rental per season!

SWIMMING LESSONS

According to the CDC children ages 1-4 who participate in formal swimming lessons are 88% less likely to drown. Let us help your children learn to be safe and strong swimmers! Group Lesson Session Dates:

Session 1 June 6-June 17

Session 2 June 20- July 1

Session 3 July 11-July 22

Session 4 July 25-August 5

The second Friday of each session is reserved for make-up classes in the event of a full class cancellation.

Classes run between 9:15am and 11:00am each session. Specific class times are set prior to each session.

Please consult the registration notebook or speak with the pool manager to determine the correct placement for your swimmer.

Private and semi-private lessons are available at your convenience. Please speak with the pool manager to make arrangements.

The cost for group lessons follows:

Parent Tot costs \$38 and runs Monday/Wednesday/Friday, Monday/Wednesday. These classes run for 25 minutes.

Levels 1-6 and Specialty Classes cost \$53 per swimmer (\$38 for 1/2 session).

*Levels 1-4 run for 25 minutes.

*Levels 5, 6 and the Specialty Classes run for 40 minutes.

***Non-members** may participate in group lessons if space is available and for an additional \$10 fee.

MEMBER CHECK-IN

The membership check-in database is designed to identify Westfield Pool Members in order to preserve the value of your membership, to promote safety and to minimize liability. Please help the lifeguards enforce this policy by checking in every time you come to the pool.

****NEW THIS SUMMER****

In order to gain access to the pool this summer, all members must sign the "Rules Acknowledgement Form" that was mailed with the summer invoice. Please make sure the form is returned to Associa by May 15th in order to avoid any delays in using the pool. The check-in database will alert staff if there are issues with membership dues or the rules acknowledgement form, and admission will be delayed until these are corrected.

PLEASE COME DOWN TO THE POOL WITHIN THE FIRST 2 WEEKS TO HAVE THE LIFEGUARDS **RETAKE** YOUR PHOTOS. Entrance will be denied to anyone who does not have their photo in the system.

GUESTS

Your family and friends are welcome to enjoy the pool with you! **Each membership household is permitted to bring up to 10 guests without approval from the manager. Please do not coordinate maxing out your guest passes with other memberships without prior approval through the pool manager. Your group may be turned away if the event wasn't prearranged with management.**

Guest passes will be distributed as follows:

Lifetime Membership: 20 complimentary individual guest passes + 1 family guest pass

Summer Family Membership: 10 complimentary individual guest passes

Summer Limited Membership: 5 complimentary individual guest passes

Additional passes can be purchased for \$20 per 5 pass card. Family guest passes can be used by one family; or one guest pass per friend.

All guests must be accompanied by a member at all times.

NON-SWIMMER WRIST BAND POLICY

Drownings happen quickly and quietly even when lifeguards and parents are present. To prevent drownings it is imperative that parents and guardians actively watch their children in and around water, even when lifeguards are on duty. Splash Pool Services and Westfield are pleased to announce a new strategy to prevent drowning. This year all "non-swimmers" will be required to wear wristbands indicating that they must have a guardian within one arms reach. Wristbands are a great visual aid indicating swimming ability. They quickly and easily help lifeguards and bystanders identify which swimmers require close supervision.

All swimmers under the age of 10 must swim one length of the pool safely in order to swim without a wristband. *That age was determined since it's the cut off for swimming unsupervised at Westfield.* If they cannot pass the swim test they must wear a wristband and be actively supervised by a guardian who is within one arms reach of them in the water. Guardians must be at least 14 years old.

Swimming ability will be noted in the membership database and non-swimmer wristbands will be given to those who need them each time they enter the facility. Swimmers may retake the swim test through out the summer in order to prove their ability to stay safe on their own. The full policy will be available at the pool. Feel free to contact Splash (*contact information on reverse*), or discuss any questions or concerns with the pool manager.

Although our lifeguards are provided to assist you with supervising your swimmers, please remember that you are ultimately responsible for the safety of your family and your guests. There is no substitute for your ACTIVE SUPERVISION!

SWIMMING AND SAFETY

ATTENTION SWIMMERS: Bullying, disrespect or profanity are not tolerated on pool grounds. Parents are responsible for teaching their children these rules.

The diving well and diving board usage will be limited to the following: The first half of the hour use of the diving board will be allowed; therefore recreational swimming in the diving well will be prohibited. The second half of the hour the diving well will be open for free swim while the diving board will be off limits.
